United States Theatrical Silver Medalist

Edward's renowned interpretations through dance and his natural style were featured on several PBS television specials including, "Live from the Imperial Palace in Vienna", and "Legends of Dance".

Since his retirement from competition, Edward has become a distinguished coach, judge, and ambassador for DanceSport. Some of his many honors include:

2003 North American Dance Award Nominee for "Choreographer of the year"

Edward is currently designated as a World Class Judge and enjoys coaching the new generation of rising dancers. He is also co-organizer of the New York Dance Festival and the Empire State DanceSport Championships.
