He also is considered to be a leading authority on Movement Theory, Analysis, and Laban Notation. Bill's life time goal has been to increase and bring quality Ballroom dancing to Massachusetts and the New England area. He is currently co - owner and organizer of the prestigious U S Eastern Dancesport Championships to take place February 17-19 2012 at The Renaissance Hotel (Waterfront Boston) and The Massachusetts Dancesport Challenge August 2012 Melrose MA.

A former owner of New England Ballroom and Dance Studios located on Newbury St. Boston, Bill now spends his time traveling as a coach, adjudicator, and Ballroom Business consultant.
